## 2010 Gary Papa Leadership in Philanthropy Award

### Joseph V. Del Raso

Joseph V. Del Raso is a partner in the law firm of Pepper Hamilton LLP. Mr. Del Raso leads the firm's Investment Management Practice Group and is co-chair of the firm's Italian Desk. He is a past member of Pepper's Executive Committee.

Mr. Del Raso is a leader in numerous diplomatic, cultural, civic and philanthropic activities, including promoting relations between Italy and the United States.

He is president of the National Italian American Foundation, the leading educational organization that promotes Italian American culture and heritage, and the national advocate for 25 million Italian Americans. He also is chairman of the board of the American University of Rome, the oldest degree-granting American university in Rome and a center for cross-cultural exchanges and promotion of international relations. Mr. Del Raso has worked closely for many years with the U.S. and Italian governments and international businesses in numerous matters, including assisting with relief efforts following the 2009 earthquake in L'Aquila, Italy, and in organizing several economic development and cultural programs. In recognition of his achievements, in June 2010 the President of Italy, Giorgio Napolitano, awarded Mr. Del Raso the title of commander (commendatore) in the Order of Merit of the Italian Republic (OMRI), the highest honor of the Italian state. Mr. Del Raso previously had been awarded the title of knight in the OMRI.

In 2007, President Bush appointed Mr. Del Raso to the President's Commission on White House Fellowships, one of America's most prestigious programs for leadership and public service. Mr. Del Raso also has long been active in leadership at Villanova University, and currently is chairman of the Board of Consultors of the Villanova School of Law and chair of the Center for Marketing and Public Policy Leadership.

In 2002, Mr. Del Raso was the only lawyer in private practice invited to testify to Congress on the then-proposed Sarbanes-Oxley Act, and in 2004 he testified again on the effects of the Act. In 2000, Mr. Del Raso served as local counsel to the Republican National Committee, handling legal and logistical arrangements for the Republican National Convention in Philadelphia. He is active in numerous local civic and charitable organizations, including the World Affairs Council, the Justinian Foundation, St. Edmond's Home for Children and many more.
